



KEY FACTS ABOUT FREE HOME REPAIRS FOR LEAD (Pb) REMOVAL

1. ELIGIBILITY

- Must have children living in the home *under* the age of 6 years
- Funds are limited** and eligibility is determined on a first-come, first-served basis, so **APPLY NOW**
- Must be a homeowner to apply. If you are a tenant who has children under the age of 6 years, the landlord would need to apply. **Home must be built BEFORE 1978**
- ALL applications must be received by **December 1st, 2025**, to be considered.

3. DETAILS ONCE YOUR APPLICATION IS APPROVED

- Allegany County will arrange to come into the home to inspect your home for LEAD, create a map outlining LEAD locations that need to be renovated or abated.
- Some items that are typically renovated or abated are walls, wall trim, windows, door jams, and floors. In some instances, exterior siding, may be covered.
- Allegany County will put out bids for EPA-licensed contractors (a grant requirement) and hire a contractor for the work. Renovations are 100% **no cost** to the applicant.
- Once the work is started, the EPA-licensed contractors must have ALL work completed within 2 weeks
- Sometimes relocation is necessary and depends on the extent of work being done. Allegany County will fund relocation expenses and meal allowance if applicable.
